**'Forgive Us Our Sins'****Points from last weeks sermon**

1. We can only truly forgive others when we understand how much we have been forgiven.
2. Remembering how much Jesus forgave will help us to forgive others.
3. People who have genuinely received God's grace will be marked by a willingness to forgive others.
4. People who have genuinely received God's grace will be marked by a willingness to continue to confess their sins.
5. As we confess our sins remember that God is able to forgive our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness - also remember the need to forgive ourselves.
6. Praying for our enemies will help us to dissolve bitterness and our desire for justice Matthew 5:44.
7. Remember these words:  
'vengeance is mine said the Lord.'
