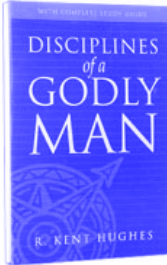

### 1. *Disciplines of a Godly Man*

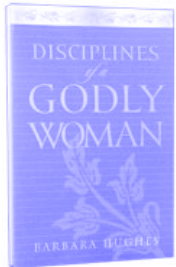
