#### **Brian Heath appointed to lead Anglican Ministry and Outreach in Asquith**

Mayor Nick Berman and other community leaders will welcome Brian Heath to his new role at St John's Asquith on January 28<sup>th</sup> 2009 at 7:30pm. The welcoming service will be conducted by Bishop Glenn Davies.

Brian has been appointed to St John's at a key time in the life of the Anglican Church.

"In 2009 we are planning one of the greatest make-Jesus-known campaigns ever seen in this country. The aim is to challenge all our churches to make contact and connect with their communities in a way we have not done before" says Anglican Archbishop Peter Jensen. Brian will be the front-line man for this major activity in Asquith, Mount Colah and Mount Kuring-gai.

St John's is a thriving community, and has recently built a \$2 million church and hall complex to house its growing membership.

"St John's already has a very active ministry in the Asquith area, but I am going to be looking at ways in which we can be more relevant to our community and better meet its needs." Brian said.

Brian comes to St John's Asquith after 12 years at St Alban's Frenchs Forest, and takes over from Gordon Lincoln who retired in July 2008 after 18 years in the role.

Before entering the ministry, Brian was a Child Protection Officer with DOCS, and is well prepared for the challenges of helping people in need.

Brian is married to Sue and has 3 daughters Vivienne, Naomi and Verity.
